Matters Arising:

Easement: G Jujnovich No Update.

Nursery: G Jujnovich No update.

- G Jujnovich handed an electronic copy of the updated Auckland Council approved LMP to - W Hojem, E Singh & M Drury.

Complaints Register:

- A Parsonage asks what channel the complaints come through. G Jujnovich informs via text, call and email.
- A Parsonage enquires as to what the minor faults were on complaint 1561, G Jujnovich responds that it was around the performance of the Odour suppression device. Monthly services of the devices are done through an independent contractor but from time to time the nozzles block up and WM changes them.
- J Hutchinson enquires if the complaints register includes complaints made directly to the Auckland Council. E Singh responds these are just WM records, If Auckland Council receives any complaint they will notify T Wiggill.
- N DeWitte enquires how the Weighbridge operator will determine if the load is odorous. G Jujnovich responds that it is based on the waste types coming in. WM receives a wide variety of waste which is not just odorous. N DeWitte suggests clearer wording.
- L Johnston wants to know if WM doing fortnightly check-ins with the school, if that is the reason for less complaints received from the school. G Jujnovich, no. WM still encourages the school to notify WM at the time of the odour.
- L Johnston asks what time the Odour Cannons are turned on. G Jujnovich states that they can only be turned on after 06:00 am and if turned on earlier there will be noise disturbance.
- A Parsonage questions if the complaints register captures all the complaints. G Jujnovich explains that it captures all the external complaints. External Complaints are outside the notional boundary but encourages everyone to make a complaint at the time of the odour. The investigation that is undertaken is still the same. Internal complaints are not required to be reported to the Auckland Council. G Jujnovich confirmed he would look at including internal complaints at the next meeting.

Operation Reports:

- N DeWitte has notice Leachate Tankers around. Questions if the Benevap is not working 100%. G Jujnovich noted that the Benevap is working and can destruct up to 50000L per 24H period. Currently WM is running it at 45000L and supplementing the balance with external haulage.
- N DeWitte asks about the 2nd Benevap and if there is any progress. G Jujnovich responds that WM is awaiting on an Iwi to provide a cultural impact statement, there is no rush at this stage for the 2nd Benevap.
- A McNeil requests that the Ngāti Rango be present at the CLC meetings. G Jujnovich mentions that he has made numerous requests, and Ngāti Rango has given assurances that they will attend the next CLC meeting.
- G Jujnovich shows that there have been significant reductions in complaints since 2021. W Holem is pleased with the report.
- G Jujnovich shows waste placement planning work and suppressant device layout planning. Cannons are actively moved based on weather patterns. G Jujnovich explains how the Odour planning works and scheduling works.
- L Johnston asks how WM geotechnically get the waste not "slip". G Jujnovich explains that there is a engineered process that allows for placement and settlement of the waste.
- G Jujnovich explains that WM is going through an operational excellence programme with external consultants who have been developing procedures, Standard works and daily duties. Seeing improvements.
- Volumes are stable at around 2500-3500 Tons Per day.
G Jujnovich states that clean clay and soil volumes have been low; however, they have started to increase this month.
- Truck numbers have been low at 195 to 205 per day.
- Managed Fill- no Changes.

- Pest Control- we have Habitat NZ here 3 times a week, 3 team members on site also do pest control through May
- Continued trial where WM is attaching the Bird Suppression device to a Compactor which will be mobile.
- J Hutchinson enquires if WM has any problems with feral cats. G Jujnovich responds that WM has no problems with feral cats.
- L Johnston requested if WM could help the community with possum traps, G Jujnovich suggested that she look at an application be brought to the Dairy Flat Community Trust as their applications open in July 2024.
- W Hojem questions if the Landfill runs any possum traps, G Jujnovich states that WM hasn't run any traps but can investigate options.
- N DeWitte requests that extra monitoring points be added on the bypass road and on the Pro-Active Monitoring report for when the wind direction is blowing in his property direction.

Regulatory Issues:

General Business:


- L Johnston asks if G Jujnovich has any update on Dome Valley, G Jujnovich responds that he's not involved in this project and can't provide an update.
- L Johnston noticed a group doing water Quality testing on the stream and asked if WM does any water quality testing. G Jujnovich responded and stated that WM does Water sampling, WM undertakes monthly and quarterly samples of the stream at specific locations. L Johnston suggested that those results be present at the next CLC meeting.
- J Hutchinson mentions that the boundaries of the Landfill are not well maintained, G Jujnovich mentioned that WM had treescapes out last year to do some maintenance, and WM will investigate the matter.
- G Jujnovich brings to Auckland Council's attention that someone has placed Bee Hives on the Bypass Roads. These need to be removed.
- J Hutchinson mentions Air space update report due in Aug.



Odour Intensity: The perceived strength of an odour above its threshold. It is determined by an odour panel and is described in categories that progress from "Not perceptible"; "Very Weak"; "Weak"; "Distinct", "Strong", "Very Strong", to "Extremely Strong".
